Scholarship Guidelines

Seattle Christian Homeschool Co-op has limited funds available to assist families in need of financial assistance to pay for specific co-op costs. Who qualifies for co-op scholarship funds?

Awarding of funds will be at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee and are limited based on the amount of money in the fund and the number of families needing assistance.

Scholarships are only available to families who have been involved in the co-op for at least one year.

A family may qualify for a scholarship if:

1. a critical crisis arises (e.g., an urgent health issue in the family or an unexpected job loss), or
2. there is another unique situation (e.g., a single parent who is homeschooling and is the sole provider)

What is expected in return?

You are to be committed to the co-op by regularly attending and fulfilling your co-op job responsibility.

What may scholarship funds be used for?

The scholarship shall only apply to supply fees for parent-taught classes. Scholarship funds may not be used for the co-op's annual registration fee or for tuition-based classes (those taught by outside teachers).
